This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case which is now stated to be listed for 25.08.2022 to an early date.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner has submitted that the petitioner seeks to withdraw the main petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise and thus, prays for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel has submitted that he has no objection in case, the date of hearing in the main case is preponed.

CRM-M-45120-2019 (O&M) and CRM-25821-2022

The main petition bearing CRM-M-45120-2019 has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.765 dated 07.10.2017 registered under Sections 406, 415, 420, 468, 471, 120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has moved an application bearing No.CRM-25821-2022 for withdrawal of the main petition in view of the fact that the matter has been compromised and now the petitioner seeks liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and as well as prayer made in application bearing No.CRM-25821-2022, the petition bearing No.CRM-M-45120-2019 is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
