[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.08.2022 in CWP No.17393 of 2022 in case titled as Satish Kumar vs. State of Haryana and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.17393 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent herein to pass appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 05.07.2022 filed by the petitioner within eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Pursuant to the notice issued to the respondent, learned AAG has produced copy of order dated 15.12.2022 passed by the respondent rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 05.07.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated 15.12.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated

15.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
