This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner qua the medical bill amounting to Rs.23959.78/- for the period from 23.12.2021 to 24.12.2021, which is submitted on 18.01.2022 vide Annexure P-6 before respondent No.3 and direction may be issued to release the entire amount along with 18% interest per annum.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representations of the petitioner dated 18.01.2022 and 17.08.2022 (Annexures P-6 & P-7) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Even counsel for respondent No.1 is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representations of the petitioner dated 18.01.2022 and 17.08.2022 (Annexures P-6 & P-7) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
