Petitioner-Gagandeep Chopra has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct fair an impartial inquiry and take stern legal action against respondents No.4 and 5.

A complaint was filed with Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar wherein a compromise/agreement was made on 20.10.2021 to the effect that petitioner's wife Harpreet Kaur would reside in her parental family and until a final decision is taken in the complaint case, her husband would not come to India from abroad Dubai.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Himani Arora, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the case file, instant petition is ***disposed of*** with the direction to Respondent No.2 to look into the representation/complaint dated 2.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and take appropriate action required as per law as early as possible.
