The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend threat at the hands of private respondents.

On 14.11.2022, notice of motion was issued to the respondents
No.1 to 3-State only.

In compliance of the above said order, a status report by way of an affidavit of Arsh Verma, Additional Superintendent of Police, Jind, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

As per the reply/status report, an enquiry was got conducted from ASI Manoj Kumar, Police Station Sadar Safidon and it transpired during enquiry that Nasib S/o Lakhwinder Singh (son of petitioner Nos.1 and 2) and Sadhika are residing in protection home at Jind in police protection since 11.11.2022. Nasib and Sadhika got their statements recorded before the police

and made the statement that they are not apprehending any danger to their life and liberty and no further police protection is required to them. During the course of enquiry, the private respondents were also joined in the enquiry and their statements (Annexures R-3 to R-6) were also recorded and they made the statement that there were not threatening the petitioners and they have no objection to the marriage from their side.

On instructions, learned State counsel has assured the Court that the life and liberty of the petitioners shall be protected.

In view of the above, no further directions are required.
