In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that they apprehend the transfer from the present place of posting despite the fact that they are entitled to continue at the present place of posting.

On being asked from learned counsel for the petitioners as to what is the basis of apprehension, nothing has been pointed out as no transfer has infact taken place so far and nothing has come on record to show that the respondents are even intending to pass any order causing prejudice to the petitioner so far.

In case, the respondents pass any order of the transfer, the petitioners will be free to approach appropriate forum in case, they feel aggrieved against the said action of the respondents.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already filed a representation dated 12.09.2022 before respondent No.2, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-5 and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
