1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1 dated 15.09.2022 in CWP-20978-2022.

2. Perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-20978-2022 was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to make a request to the authorities concerned for the grievance which was the subject matter of the writ petition.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the request submitted by the petitioner to the respondent in terms of liberty granted vide order Annexure P-1 has been decided vide order dated 14.12.2022 and copy thereof supplied to the petitioner and in view of the request of the petitioner having been accepted, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same. Order dated 14.12.2022 is taken on record.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
