VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.118 dated 23.09.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Division No.4, District Jalandhar Commissionerate and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

In pursuance of order dated 17.11.2022 passed by this Court, vide which, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording of their statements with respect to compromise effected between them, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has submitted its report stating that none has appeared before the trial Court.

From the above facts, it is apparent that the compromise is not fructified and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition in case the compromise is still effectual and the parties are ready to get their statements recorded before the trial Court with respect to compromise effected between them.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
