The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.3 to decide/reply to the legal notice/representation dated 25.07.2022 as (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner has sent legal notice/representation dated 25.07.2022 to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar regarding the update on the status of action taken on the recommendation of the S.P Jhajjar vide Letter No.3279-P dated 27.10.2020 on the basis of the Investigation Report of D.S.P. Bahadurgarh and approval for FIR etc. against one Jag Niwas, ADC Jhajjar then SDM-Sub-Divisional Officer (C), Bahadurgarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case the

respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar is directed to look into the representation/Legal Notice dated 25.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Mr. Vivek Saini, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection in the event such prayer of the petitioner as aforesaid is accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with consent and without commenting on the merits of the claim, with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar to examine the grievance espoused by the petitioner in the representation/Legal Notice dated 25.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon within a period of 02 months of the receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
