Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner, so that he may not become a victim of continuous subjugation and prosecution inflicted upon him by respondent No.3 under the influence of the private respondents.

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 09.01.2020, pursuant to which a reply dated 31.03.2021 by way of affidavit of Waryam Singh PPS, ACT (Central), Ludhiana, has been filed.

Learned State counsel refers to paragraphs 2 to 5 of the reply to submit that the matter had been gone into and no danger to life and liberty of the petitioner was found and also that SHO, Ludhiana, did not harass the petitioner.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such
