The petitioners are seeking to quash FIR No. 73 dated 09.06.2019 under Sections 323/498-A/34 IPC registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the matrimonial dispute had cropped up between the parties. At the earlier instance, petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 had resumed cohabitation but subsequently, they have again started residing separate from each other. The petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 have also instituted a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage by mutual consent. Accordingly, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
