1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.05.2022, in CWP-9207-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-9207-2022, was disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide legal notice dated 29.03.2022, by passing a speaking order, within five months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 29.11.2022, accepting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 29.03.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same, states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order Annexure dated 29.11.2022, to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
