Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of order dated 07.04.2021 passed by the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga in FIR No.0143 dated 28.08.2020, under Sections 363, 366-A of IPC, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present FIR was lodged by mother of the prosecutrix on account of misunderstanding. He has further submitted that both the petitioner and the prosecutrix are duly married and now the matter has been amicably resolved. He also submits that the parties have filed the petition bearing CRM-M-52553-2022 for quashing of the FIR which is pending adjudication before this Court for 14.03.2023. He submits that the petitioner was erroneously declared Proclaimed Person.

After arguing for some time, he prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Court of competent jurisdiction. In case the petitioner surrenders before the Court of competent jurisdiction within seven days from today and files an

appropriate application for redressal of his grievances, the Court concerned is directed to decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.

Petition is disposed of in above-said terms.
