Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.9 dated 02.03.2019, under Sections 498-A, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 313 IPC added vide DDR No.16 dated 24.08.2019), registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 09.12.2019 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 09.12.2019, petitioners have already joined the investigation. He also submits that the matter was referred to the Mediation Centre and the same remain successful and all the outstanding issues have been resolved amicably. As such, their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the abovesaid fact.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 09.12.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
