Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that petitioner is entitled for the grant of selection grade of ₹7,000/- to ₹12000/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for the said benefit keeping in view the settled principle of law as well as the fact that same has already been extended to the similarly situated employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 15.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 15.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 15.02.2020 (Annexure P-6), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
