Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuing directions to official respondents to release the dues of petitioner's late husband alongwith all pensionary benefits in favour of petitioner; further to consider the name of petitioner for compassionate appointment in place of her husband, who died in harness during his service on 12.11.2020.

At the outset, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case her representation dated 13.06.2022 (P-10) pending with the respondents, is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s)-State and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is **disposed off** with direction to respondents to consider and decide the above representation as

per law, within four (04) weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
