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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)**

As per averments made in the petition, petitioner stands convicted in FIR No. 362 dated 10.10.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 and 34 of the IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station A-Division, District Amritsar.

Petitioner was sentenced to undergo 20 years rigorous imprisonment and is currently serving out his sentence at Central Jail, Amritsar.

Prayer in the instant petition is for grant of parole for a period of six weeks on the basis that father of the petitioner is suffering from some medical ailment.

A copy of the petition had been furnished to learned State counsel on the previous date of hearing i.e.18.11.2022.

Mr.Gurpreet Singh, learned Addl. AG, Punjab, upon instructions from Kulwant Singh ASI, Police Station Verka, Amritsar, makes a statement that in case the petitioner were to file an application seeking parole, the same would be considered by the competent authority in accordance with law and a final decision thereupon would be taken within a period of 10 days from the date of submission of such application.

Statement is accepted.

No further directions are required to be passed.
