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**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)**

At the outset, learned counsel for the parties submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties in view of the terms & conditions arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Therefore, the present appeal may be disposed of as infructuous.

In view of the oral joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main case is taken up for hearing today itself.

A perusal of the report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court reveals that the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable settlement/agreement. The said terms of the settlement/agreement are also placed in the case file. Besides this, vide CM-5506-C-2021, which was filed by the learned counsel for the appellant to place on record the affidavits dated 27.10.2021 of both the respondents/plaintiffs as Annexures A & B, respectively. Wherein, notice of motion too was issued to the counsel for the non-applicants/respondents.

Therefore, Annexures A & B are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. CM-5506-C-2021 stands disposed of accordingly.

Since, the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and keeping in view the affidavits dated 27.10.2021 of both the respondents/plaintiffs (Annexures A & B), the present appeal stands disposed of being infructuous.
