DEEPAK GUPTA, J.

Ex-parte judgment and decree dated 22.11.2018 (Annexure P.1) was passed by the learned trial Court in Civil Suit bearing CNR No.HRS102-000202-2016 titled Himanshu Gupta Vs. Insurance Company Regulatory and Development Authority. The suit was decreed by directing the defendants to issue the Motor Surveyor License and the appointment letter in favour of the plaintiff-petitioner. The execution filed by the said plaintiff was directed to be transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Hyderabad (Telangana) through learned District Judge, Sirsa for further execution after noticing that both the judgment debtors (now respondents) were residents of Hyderabad, vide order dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P.4). This petition is against the said order dated 10.10.2022.

At this stage, Mr. Akshay Jain, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has already received the advance copy. It is pointed out that application under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC for setting aside ex parte judgment and decree dated 22.11.2018 has already been moved by the defendants and the same is fixed for consideration on 17.01.2023.

Heard. It is directed that any order to be passed in execution shall remain in abeyance, till the application under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC of the defendants-JDs-respondents is disposed of.

With this direction, present revision stands disposed of.
