Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for directing respondents to conduct fair investigation and arrest the accused persons in case FIR No.218 dated 12.10.2022 lodged for offences under Sections 304-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Alewa, District Jind (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's daughter was married to Vikas on 22.05.2022 and within a few months of her wedding, she has been done to death by her husband and his relatives. He submits that deceased was tortured as the accused were not satisfied with the dowry. Counsel submits that FIR has been registered by the petitioner, but no action has been taken to apprehend the accused despite representation dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-2). He submits that petitioner would be satisfied in

case a direction is issued to the official respondent to look into representation (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State. Upon instructions received from SI Balwan, she submits that main accused, Vikas has been arrested and raids are being conducted to apprehend the co-accused.

Considering the nature of allegations, petition is disposed of by directing official respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jind to examine the representation dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
