Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the appeal, petitioner could not appear on 31.10.2022 as he was suffering from high level sugar. Learned trial Court dismissed the application for exemption from personal appearance of petitioner-Rameshwar Verma, on the ground that the same was not supported by medical certificate.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into account the fact that since petitioner has approached this Court immediately after issuance of warrant of arrest, instant petition is **disposed of** with the observation that the petitioner may surrender before the Appellate Court concerned and move an application for bail which shall be decided on or before 30.11.2022. Till then arrest of the petitioner is stayed and if in the event of bail application is dismissed then his arrest is further stayed for two weeks thereafter.
