Complaining wilful violation of the order dated 12.10.2022 passed in CWP-19206-2022, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 read with Section 14 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order dated 12.10.2022-reads as under:-

“The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Meanwhile, status quo as it exists today shall be maintained.”

Sh.Sandeep Chopra, DAG, Punjab, enters appearance on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from Ms. Neetu Rani, Junior Assistant, states that the petitioner has been called for a hearing on 23.11.2022. He submits that the speaking order, as directed by the Court, will be passed either on 23.11.2022 itself or within a period of 2-3 days thereafter.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall have the liberty to file an application for revival, if the order is not complied with. The respondent is impressed upon to not only pass the order within the period specified but to also ensure delivery of a copy of the order to the petitioner, within the aforesaid time against a proper receipt.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
