Challenge in the present petition is to the orders dated 22.08.2016 and 10.11.2016 passed by learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in case bearing FIR No.74 dated 08.05.2012, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, under Sections 420, 467 and 471 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 30.10.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and was released on interim bail on 08.11.2019 by learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel and learned counsel for the complainant do not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, but without going into the merits of the

case, the order dated 30.10.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
