1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.03.2018, in CWP-7571-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 27.03.2018, reveals that CWP-7571-2018, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 20.02.2017 and take a conscious decision in respect thereto by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and instructions issued by the government from time to time, within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1, the respondents have passed order dated 13.02.2020, rejecting the claim made in legal notice dated 20.02.2017 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 13.02.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with

law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
