Prayer in these petitions is for quashing of FIR No.58 dated 15.05.2015 registered under Sections 380, 465, 471, 506 IPC at Police Station Divison No.3, Jalandhar City, District Jalandhar and FIR No.178 dated 03.11.2017 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 193, 120-B IPC at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

As per the reports dated 17.12.2019 and dated 10.01.2020, submitted by the trial Court, no compromise is effected between the parties as the complainant has not supported the compromise.

Accordingly, both these petitions are disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

However, counsel for the petitioners, at this stage, argued that on an earlier occasion, the petitioners have filed CRM-M No.25256 of 2016, with a prayer to quash the FIR on merits, however, the same was rendered infructuous as later on, this petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise was filed and the petitioners have already moved an application for revival of the same, which is pending for 19.12.2022.

Be whatsoever, considering the fact that in these petitions, there is no compromise effected between the parties and the same is accordingly, rendered infructuous.
