SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner, as he is having serious threat perception at the hands of respondents No.6 to 10, which includes the police officials by name particularly respondent No.5-Mahesh Saini, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Traffic), Mohali, Punjab.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 18.11.2022, respondent-State was directed to file reply by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali. Though reply has not been filed but Mr. Harinder Singh Mann, DSP City, Mohali is present in Court to assist the Court.

On instruction from Mr. Mann, learned State counsel submits that the inquiry which is pending with respondent No.5-DSP (Traffic), Mohali has been transferred to respondent No.4-DSP (D), Mohali, who has concluded the inquiry and the complaint has been filed.

In view of the same, nothing survives in the present petition, at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off, as having been rendered infructuous.

However, petitioner will be at liberty to represent the competent authority, if so advised or need arises.
