Through this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.208 dated 29.07.2020, registered at Police Station Sector 13/17, District Panipat, under Section 384 IPC, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the present case, challan was presented on 07.10.2020; that charges were framed on 11.11.2020; that the complainant and the eye-witness, driver and cleaner of the truck, respectively, have turned hostile, and that departmental proceedings are going on against the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed

of with a direction to the trial Court to make an endeavour to conclude the trial at the earliest.
