The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking quashing of the order dated 19.01.2019, by which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

This Court on 24.10.2019 had issued notice of motion and had directed that upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of that Court.
