The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned notice dated 04.09.2019 (Annexure P-1). A further prayer has been made for seeking restoration of the rebate promised under Clause 15 of the Franchisee Agreement dated 24.08.2017 along with interest for the rebate wrongly withheld from the petitioner.

Taking into consideration that the nature of the dispute pertains to a billing dispute as well as the dues under the contractual arrangement providing for separate statutory/contractual remedies, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage so as to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberties as aforesaid.
