This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.62 dated 29.08.2021 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

On oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is impleaded as respondent No.2. Registry is directed to do the needful.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to consider and decide the representations dated 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-2 & P-3-Marked to DGP, Punjab) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present

petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representations, as indicated above, are indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
