The Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others have filed this revision petition assailing the correctness of the orders passed by the Executing Court on 18.07.2019 and 16.09.2019. The warrants of the attachment of the property of the petitioner-Corporation have been issued.

On a suit filed by respondent No.1, claiming decree of declaration with a direction to the department to remove the pay anomaly between him and Bachitter Singh, the trial court on 31.08.2017, passed a decree, operative part whereof reads as under:-

“it is ordered that the suit of the plaintiff succeeds and same is hereby decreed with no order as to costs. The defendant department is directed to trace out original service book of the plaintiff and to remove pay anomaly between plaintiff the defendants.”

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the anomaly in the pay has been removed and the respondents have already been paid the amount of payment with simple interest.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

The revision petition is rendered infructuous.

The decree shall stand satisfied.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
