The instant writ petition has been preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent to correct the date of birth of the petitioner in Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1). A further prayer has been made to direct the respondent to decide the representation dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner for correction of his date of birth.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner passed his secondary education on 30.07.2021 and thereafter, started preparing for IELTS Exam. She further contends that when the petitioner applied for passport, he came to know that his date of birth has been wrongly mentioned in the Aadhar Card as 01.02.2001 instead of 11.12.2003 and

therefore, the present petition has been filed for issuing directions for correction of the same.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in a case a direction is issued to the respondent to decide the representation dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

Taking into consideration that an alternative prayer has been made to the extent that the legal notice be decided by the respondent in a time bound manner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to look into the grievance espoused by the petitioner in the representation dated 13.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and reasoned order thereupon in accordance with law and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
