MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.62 dated 5.10.2019 under Sections 498A, 406 IPC registered at Police Station Women District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that despite an undertaking given by the petitioner before this Court on 28.2.2020 that he would settle the dispute with the complainant wife after paying her a lump sum amount of Rs. 17 lakh, he had resiled from the same and not even paid a single penny to her. He further submits that it was thus evident that the petitioner under the garb of the interim order dated 25.11.2019, vide which his arrest had been stayed was buying time and had given a false undertaking.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded that the petitioner has indeed resiled from the undertaking given before this Court

and has failed to make payment in compliance of order dated 28.2.2020.

In the facts and circumstances, as enumerated hereinabove, the petition is dismissed.
