The petitioner herein seeks directions for regularization of his services as Sewadar/Peon at Muktsar Central Cooperative Bank.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this regard, the petitioner has already approached the respondents by way of representations dated 11.07.2022 and 21.09.2022, but no action has been taken thereon. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case his latest representation dated 21.09.2022, Annexure P-3, is decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let sufficient number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representation dated 21.09.2022, Annexure P-3, of the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
