Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 30.07.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Bagapurana, District Moga.

Vide order dated 18.01.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 18.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner. He submits that the recovery of dowry articles still remains to be effected from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 18.01.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
