Three interlocutory orders passed by the trial Court are subject matter of three different revision petitions before this Court. In fact, two suits were filed against the petitioner (Smt. Mohinder Kaur). One filed by Sh. Gurlal, her vendor, whereas the second filed by the Sh. Gurdhian Singh,

who claims the execution of a prior agreement of sell by Sh. Gurlal. The suit filed by Sh. Gurdhian Singh, in which the petitioner is a party, has already been decreed vide judgment and decree dated 02.09.2022. The petitioner wishes to examine the scribe of a receipt dated 29.09.2011 in the second suit. The aforesaid receipt has already been disbelieved in the judgment passed by the Court in **Gurdhian Singh vs. Gurlal Singh and others**, dated 02.09.2022.

This Bench has heard the learned counsels representing the parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paper book.

Without going into the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to dispose of the revision petitions while granting liberty to the petitioner to assail the correctness of these interlocutory orders while filing the appeal against the main judgment, if any, if the suit is decided against the petitioner. This course is permissible under Order 43 Rule 1-A introduced by the Act No.104 of 1976 in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
