Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though, it is the prerogative of the State to post an employee keeping in view the administrative exigency but keeping in view the allegations being alleged in the present petition and the averments being made that the petitioner is suffering harassment, the petitioner had requested the authorities concerned to post him somewhere else.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already requested the respondents-authorities by way of filing representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said request.

Mr. Teevar Sharma, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in

deciding representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/8), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 08.10.2022 (Annexure P/8) by passing a speaking order within a period of 03 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
