RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 09.06.2022 in case FIR No.390 dated 29.10.2018, under Sections 452, 323, 354, 379, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana wherein, NBWs had been issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail and due to COVID-19, he was informed that the Courts are not working. He also submits that the matter is also amicably resolved between petitioner and the complainant and on account of the same, he believed that the case has come to an end and hence, he remained absent. He submits that the police raided the house of the petitioner in pursuance to the NBWs issued against him.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Court of competent jurisdiction for redressal of his grievances. However, he has submitted that the petitioner may be granted some protection. In case the petitioner approaches the Court

concerned within seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and files an appropriate application for redressal of his grievances, his arrest would remain stayed for seven days thereafter from the date of filing of the application. In case, he files an application, the Court concerned would decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law. The operation of order issuing non-bailable warrants be kept in abeyance till then.
