1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in CRWP-4419-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRWP-4419-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 07.05.2022 served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, within three months.

3. Pursuant to notice issued to the respondent, compliance report-cum-reply dated 07.12.2022, along with copy of speaking order dated 26.05.2022 was filed on 08.12.2022, but the case was adjourned for today as neither counsel for the petitioner nor any other person was present on behalf of the petitioner on said date, while directing compliance report-cum-reply to be furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Today, learned AAG, Punjab, states that copy of compliance report-cum-reply was furnished to Shri Rakesh Kumar, Advocate, on

08.12.2022, via email. However, today, also neither Shri Rakesh Kumar, Advocate is present nor anyone else is present on behalf of the petitioner.

5. Learned AAG, Punjab, states that in view of the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation filed by the petitioner having been decided vide order dated 07.05.2022, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

6. Accordingly, taking into account the position as noted above besides absence of counsel for the petitioner on 08.12.2022 as well as today, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter, therefore the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause survives.
