Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to give appointment to the petitioner on Group 'D' post, per advertisement No.04/2018 dated 25.08.2018, at par with other counterparts.

2. *Qua* his grievance, petitioner has also served representations dated 27.01.2022 & 10.03.2022 (Annexures P-10 & P-11), but the same have not been adverted by respondents till date. Hence the petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representations dated 27.01.2022 & 10.03.2022 (Annexures P-10 & P-11) by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representations, as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the pending representations dated 27.01.2022 & 10.03.2022 (Annexures P-10 & P-11) of the petitioner, and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
