This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., for seeking interim bail to the petitioner for period of one week, in case FIR No.16, dated 01.02.2020, under Sections 15 and 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, on account of marriage of niece of the petitioner, which is scheduled for 25.11.2022 and the ceremonies will start from 23.11.2022.

In pursuance to the last order dated 22.11.2022, passed by this Court, learned State counsel has submitted a report of Station House Officer, Police Station Tanda, dated 22.11.2022, which is taken on record. As per the said report, the factum of marriage of the niece of the petitioner scheduled for 25.11.2022, has been found to be true and correct.

In view of the above, the prayer made in the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail from 23.11.2022 at 5:00 p.m., today forthwith till 27.11.2022, subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender back with the Jail Authorities concerned at 5:00 p.m., on 27.11.2022.

The present petition is disposed off, as such.
