The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Shamsheer Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana, District Nuh has been filed on behalf of respondent-State.

It has been submitted by learned State counsel that an enquiry has been conducted by the local police and during the course of enquiry, the petitioners and private respondents No. 4 to 6 were joined in the proceedings and their statements have been recorded. The respondents No. 4 to 6 have categorically stated before the police that the petitioners have solemnized the marriage at their own free will and they have nothing to do with their marriage. The statements of private respondents No. 4 to 6 were placed on record as (Annexures R-1 to R-3). The local police also recorded the statements of petitioners No. 1 and 2 during the said proceedings and even they stated that at present they do not apprehend any danger to their life and liberty.

Even though the petitioners have appeared before the police and made their respective statements that they do not apprehend any danger to their

life and liberty, still the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they still apprehend danger to their life and liberty.

In view of the fact that the petitioners as well as respondents No. 4 to 6 have been examined by the police during the enquiry proceedings and the report has been submitted by the local police to the effect that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, no further directions are required.

This petition is disposed of.
