HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.2, to call upon respondents No.4 to 6, not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by summoning him to the police station time and again and for issuance of further directions to respondents No.2 and 6 to provide at least 10 days' prior notice to the petitioner in case he is required in any complaint or case registered against him.

At the outset, learned APP, U.T. Chandigarh, submits that if required in any complaint, the petitioner will be served a week's prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T.

Chandigarh, to give a week's prior notice to the petitioner, before registration of an FIR and/or initiation of further proceedings against him.

However, this order shall not be a bar on any action to be taken by the police against the petitioner, in accordance with law.
