1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 21.09.2022, in CRM-M-38073-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M-38073-2022, was disposed of vide order dated 21.09.2022, on the statement of learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Sukhwinder Singh, ASI, Police Station FatehgarhChurian, that cancellation report was almost ready and would be filed before the learned Illaqa Magistrate within four weeks.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI, Nirmal Singh, has made a statement at the bar that cancellation report in case FIR No.30 dated 16.04.2021, registered under Sections 323, 325, 506, 120-B, 148 and 149 of the IPC, at Police Station FatehgarhChurian, has been filed before the Court of the learned Illaqa Magistrate today.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner state that in view of the aforementioned statement of the learned AAG, Punjab, he does not press the instant petition.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
