Prayer in present petition filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.36 dated 01.02.2018 (Annexure P-1), under Section 304-A, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, stating *inter alia* that the same is nothing but a sheer misuse of process of law.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondent No.2, however, in view of judgment dated 23.11.2022, passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner (co-accused) in connected petition, i.e. CRM-M-10285-2019, whereby the petitioner herein has been acquitted in this case by the trial Court, the present petition has become infructuous.

The aforesaid fact has also not been denied by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
