The appellant has come up in appeal against the judgment and decree dated 30.10.2014 whereby petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce was allowed.

Vide order dated 17.09.2021, the present appeal has been converted into a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 as the parties have agreed mutually to separate and payment of Rs.9,50,000/- lacs towards permanent alimony has been agreed by the appellant.

Parties are present in Court today and they have made their respective statements which are taken on record. As per the statement of the appellant, she states that she has settled the matter mutually and she has received Rs.3,50,000/- on 11.11.2021, Rs.3,00,000/- on 08.03.2022 and today, she has received a draft bearing No. 739886 dated 21.09.2022 issued

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by State Bank of India, Jalandhar amounting to Rs.3,00,000/-. She has received the total amount of Rs.9,50,000/- towards permanent alimony. She will not initiate any case or proceedings against the respondent in future. She wants to withdraw the instant appeal. The respondent has also made a statement to this effect.

Keeping in view the statements made by both the parties, the appellant wants to withdraw the instant appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
