DEEPAK MANCHANDA J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for directing respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to conduct enquiry in the representation (Annexure P-1) and to take legal action against the private respondents as per law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was attacked by the private respondents and gave beatings to her, but when she approached the respondent No. 3-SHO, Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, they pressurized the petitioner to compromise the matter with the private respondents. It is further contended that petitioner has sent a written representation in this regard to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, which has not been taken into consideration and he would be satisfied if the same is decided.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Ferry Sofat, DAG Punjab who is present in the Court accpets notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and states that he has not objection if the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is allowed.

Therefore, with the consent of both parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 26.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law, after taking into consideration all relevant aspects.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
