This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents for providing adequate security cover to the petitioner which is on high risk at the hands of unknown miscreant ailments (posing as Gangsters/Terrorists) and on the basis of threat perception and with further direction to official respondents to decide the representation dated 07.06.2022 (P-3) submitted by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ravinder Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.4 – Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation dated 03.10.2022 (Annexure P-7) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for his life and liberty along with his family members.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.4 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
