[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 30.08.2022, in CWP-19274-2022 in case titled as '**Praveen and others versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-19274-2022 was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into the collective representations dated 18.08.2022 filed by the petitioners and pass an administrative order on the same in accordance with law and in the event of the claim of the petitioners being accepted, to take further steps to make recommendation as per merit within 30 days.

[3] Although, notice has not been issued in the instant case but learned Asstt. AG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 14.12.2022, recommending the names of the petitioners to the concerned department for appointment on the post against which they had

supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of communication dated 14.12.2022, recommending the names of the petitioners for the post which they had applied to the concerned departments/Corporations, he does not press the instant petition.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
