This revision has been filed under Article 227 Constitution of India seeking quashing of order dated 07.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Chandigarh in a civil suit titled as *Manpreet Singh Vs. M/s Design Boxed & others*", whereby preliminary issue has been decided in favour of respondent/plaintiff.

Learned counsel for the petitioners (defendants) states that the plaintiff/respondent-Manpreet Singh is husband of petitioner No.3 Gunjeet Kaur and because of a matrimonial discord, he brought a suit for recovery of Rs.28,25,000/- against the defendants, but during the pendency of this revision petition, the dispute between the parties is settled and they have decided to sever the matrimonial relations. He states that the plaintiff has agreed to withdraw his suit, but proceedings before the trial Court are stayed, the necessary application is yet to be filed.

Learned counsel states that in view of the compromise, nothing

survives for adjudication on merits in this petition and prays for withdrawal.
